

**JOURNEY TO 2030 Outreach**  
**MetroWest Growth Management Committee – Transportation Task Force Meeting**

MPO staff provided a brief overview of JOURNEY TO 2030, including the tasks to be undertaken and the public involvement activities that will occur over the course of the Plan's development. The Corridor and Connection Needs Map and the Universe of Projects Map were provided at the meeting for the attendees to review and mark up with any additional needs to include.

Attendees asked questions about the topics and included their ideas on the maps. These ideas will be incorporated into the comment matrix and the universe of projects, if applicable. Comments included:

*Transportation Needs:*

- Construct HOV lanes on Route 128, I-495, and I-90, which are regulated electronically without physical barriers (but high fines)
- Transportation improvements on Route 20 between Watertown and Marlborough
- Transportation improvements along Route 85 between I-90 in Southborough and I-495 in Milford
- Transportation improvements on Route 126 between Route 9 in Natick and Route 16 in Holliston
- Transportation improvements on Speen Street between I-90 and Route 135 in Natick
- Transportation improvements on Route 27 between I-90 and Route 135 in Natick
- Transportation improvements on Route 135 between Route 126 and Speen Street in Natick
- Transportation improvements on Route 30 between Route 126 in Framingham and Speen Street in Natick
- Transportation improvements on Nobscot Road/Edgell Road between Route 20 in Sudbury and I-90 in Framingham
