Your voice matters.

Every four years, the Boston Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) identifies the strengths and weaknesses of the region's transportation system and creates a **20-year plan to improve mobility and safety** throughout its **97 cities and towns**.

Charting Progress to 2040 was the MPO's first Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) that, in addition to funding major roadway and transit projects, set aside at least half of the MPO's funding for smaller projects that improve mobility and safety for all users, including **bicyclists, pedestrians, motorists, and transit riders**. We listened to people throughout the region who told us that they wanted diverse transportation options.
